The sound effects are also poor, and the game is not very addictive There is an average title screen describing this 'game', but no matter what I say, this game is terrible, and at nearly £7 it's way overpriced.

This game is one of the few profesionally written sports simulations for the Oric/Atmos. As the title suggests, this game includes 3 events to compete in.

Sport 1 is...Archery. You must wait until the target is in line with your crossbow then fire, the longer the fire button/space bar is held down determines the height of your shot. You get 6 attempts to reach a score of 360. This isn't too difficult after practice, and qualifies you for sport 2. This next event is rowing, and is great fun. You must move the joystick left and right, or press alternate keys, to move the oars faster. You race a computer controlled rower who is hard to beat, their is a brillial scrolling background of ice-topped mountains.

Sport 3 is weightlifting, you must hammer the spacebar/fire button as fast as possible to lift the weight, I found this last sport exausting and impossible overall, the game features some brilliant graphics and after the events you see the winner standing on his stand, with the other two standing nearby. Up to 4 people can play, 2 at a time in the rowing. I enjoyed rowing the best, but all 3 are good fun. This is a program well produced.

This game is more of a Dungeons and Dragons adventure than most others. To start, you read loads of instructions, but you can read these on the inlay card. Then you enter your name and wait for a while, which is a bit too long. Your mission is to search rooms of a number of castle levels, their are at least fifty rooms on each level ! You have to find the Holy Grail. The level is displayed as many small squares representing each room, then you must enter N,S,E or W(for the compass directions) to move. If their is a monster in the room then you can retreat(R) or Fight (A/F). You might win and if so then you get some gold, useful for later. If you lose then you add one point to the hits number, ten hits and you're dead. Strength is also important, you lose a couple of these points when you move, and fight. When fighting an Orc, Goblin, Dragon, Wolf or other monster, then you can lose a weapon or armour (they can be smashed) that you may have found on the way, these help in the fights. If you find a strength potion then this helps quite a bit, you can also find gold and gems. If you meet a trader then you can ignore him (I) or trade with him (T). He will buy gems off you, for up to 100 gold pieces. When you've got all the required gold then you can buy wound salves for strength, or healing for the 'hits' points to go down, I usually have the hits at -5 or -6. You might walk into a warp, which places you on a random room, at a random leve which could be dangerous if you land on a Wolf. You can go up & down levels via stairsif they're found, or you actually might find the Holy Grail before dieing ! I first read the instruction whilst loading the game and was looking forward to playing it, but it doesn't have anything to it I'm afraid to say. The game sounds very good, but ends up as a run-of-the-mill adventure. But all that put aside, it did hold me for about 1 an hour.
